We're seeing <u>heavy</u> clouds and a few snow <u>flurries</u> right now, but we have some <u>nasty</u> winter weather ahead, with <u>icy</u> winds and record <u>low</u> temperatures at night. Be careful if you go out in the <u>driving</u> snow, especially if you're on a road where the snow hasn't yet been <u>cleared</u>. The snow will probably **thaw** next week, as we're expecting some <u>unseasonably</u> warm weather.
